On February 20, 1987, UNITED FOOD & COMMERCIAL WORKERS UNION, LOCAL 480, filed two unfair labor practice complaints against HAWAIIAN MILLING CORPORATION alleging violations of §§ 377-6(1), (2), (3) and (4) and 377-6(1) and (4), Hawaii Revised Statutes [hereinafter referred to as HRS].
