ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On April 9, 1987, the United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as UPW], filed with this Board a Motion to Intervene in the above-entitled case. Although counsel for UPW failed to properly file a Petition for Intervention as provided for in Administrative Rules § 12-42-22, the information provided in the subject motion, affidavit of counsel, and memorandum submitted in support of the motion is deemed to be sufficient for our purposes. As the UPW is presently certified as the exclusive representative of bargaining unit 10 (Nonprofessional hospital and institutional workers), it is deemed to satisfy the requirements of Section 89-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and Administrative Rules § 12-42-22(b)(4).

Accordingly, the subject Motion to Intervene is granted.
