ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, MOTION
FOR PARTICULARIZATION OF COMPLAINT

On June 2, 1987, Respondent, JOHN WAIHEE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Upon review of the aforesaid Motion and affidavit and the charges set forth in the Complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's Motion should be granted pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-45(b).

Complainant is directed to file with this Board a written particularization setting forth (1) the bargaining unit of which he is a member; and (2) the incident or incidents giving rise to the alleged violations, including the names of relevant persons and the dates of incidents.

The Board directs Complainant to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the requested Particularization with proof of service upon Respondent no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of this Order.

If Complainant fails to timely file and serve the Particularization, the Board shall dismiss the subject Prohibited Practice Complaint.

Respondent is directed to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the Answer with proof of service upon Complainant no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of Complainant's Particularization. The failure of Respondent to timely file his answer shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the Complaint and Particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
