After a hearing on various filings submitted to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as Board] noted in the Notice of Hearing, dated November 2, 1987, the Board hereby accepts Claimant's Withdrawal of Motion for Withdrawal of Complaint.

Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA] and CHARLES K. Y. KHIM's Withdrawal of Counter-Complaint, or in the Alternative, Counter Petition for Declaratory Order, proffered at the hearing on November 16, 1987, are also hereby accepted.

Complainant's Motion for Leave to File First Amended Complaint is hereby granted. Pursuant to said motion, CHARLES K. Y. KHIM and STANLEY LING are hereby dismissed as parties to this case.

As agreed at the hearing on November 16, 1987, all parties shall submit written briefs to the Board on the issue of which charges included in Complainant's first amended complaint fall under the jurisdiction of this Board, and which issues are foreclosed by the statute of limitations, the doctrine of res judicata, or other jurisdictional doctrines.

Simultaneous reply briefs shall be due from the parties on a date to be set by the Board after receipt of the simultaneous opening briefs.
