ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On December 28, 1987, counsel for the HAWAII TEAMSTERS & ALLIED WORKERS, LOCAL 996, INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS [hereinafter referred to as TEAMSTERS], made an oral motion to continue the hearings in this matter until the first week of February, 1988. The purpose for the continuance was to allow TEAMSTERS' President Arthur Rutledge to pursue communications with its international.

Counsel for the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as UPW], opposed the continuance.

Counsel appearing on behalf of JOHN WAIHEE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, took no position on the motion for continuance.

After considering the arguments of counsel, the Board hereby grants the motion for continuance of the hearing.

In addition, counsel for the UPW moved this Board to reconsider its previous ruling denying its motion to dismiss based on the recent AFL-CIO affiliation of the TEAMSTERS. After considering the comments of counsel for the TEAMSTERS and UPW, the UPW's motion is denied.
