ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES FOR DISPOSITION AND  
NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On May 12, 1987, BUDDY H. KIMURA filed a prohibited practice complaint against JOHN WAIHEE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, alleging violation of § 89-13(a) (8), Hawaii Revised Statutes [hereinafter referred to as HRS]. Similarly, on May 15, 1987, Complainant filed a prohibited practice complaint against UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, Local 646, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, alleging violation of §§ 89-13(b) (1) and (4), 89-3 and 89-8, HRS.

As these complaints involve the same parties and overlapping issues, the Board finds that consolidation of the proceedings would be conducive to the proper dispatch of business and the ends of justice and will not unduly delay the proceedings. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(13), these complaints and the proceedings thereon are hereby consolidated for disposition.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing pursuant to §§ 89-5(b)(4) and 89-14, HRS, and Administrative Rules §§ 12-42-49 and 12-42-8(g), on the instant complaint on February 16, 1988 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board's hearings room, Room 203, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. The purpose of the hearing is to receive evidence and arguments on whether Respondents committed prohibited practices against Complainant. The hearing may continue from day to day until completed.

All parties have the right to appear in person and to be represented by counsel or other representative.
