ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR TAKING DEPOSITION UPON ORAL EXAMINATION

On June 25, 1987, counsel for Complainant HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, City and County of Honolulu, filed an Application for Taking Deposition Upon Oral Examination with the Board. By this application, counsel for Complainant requested leave of the Board to take the deposition of Richard C. Kadota, the Grievant in the related arbitration proceeding. On February 23, 1987, counsel for Complainant filed a Memorandum in Support of Application for Taking Deposition Upon Oral Examination. Counsel for Complainant indicates that the deposition of Kadota is desired as (1) it will lead to a clearer understanding of the issues in this case; (2) it will insure the parties of a full and fair hearing before this Board by preventing "surprise" tactics; (3) it will promote an orderly and timely hearing without undue delays; and (4) Complainant has no other means to ascertain what factual matters are truly in dispute between the parties.

Respondent STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS did not submit a memorandum in opposition to the Complainant's application for the taking of Mr. Kadota's deposition.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's application pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g) (6).
