ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE  
DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF EXCEPTIONS TO PROPOSED  
FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

On March 28, 1988, Complainant UNITED FOOD & COMMERCIAL WORKERS UNION, LOCAL 480, AFL-CIO, by and through its attorneys The Law Offices of Shigemura & Harakal, filed a Motion to Continue Deadline For the Filing of Exceptions to Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order with this Board. Complainant requested an extension of time from March 28, 1988 to April 4, 1988 within which to file exceptions in this matter.

In a supporting affidavit attached thereto, Randall N.
