ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION  
OF THE PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On July 29, 1976, Respondent, Harry Boranian, City and County of Honolulu, by his attorney, filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of the Complaint in accordance with Board Rule 3.05(c). Upon review of the amended complaint and the Respondent's motion, the Board is of the opinion that the complaint is so vague and indefinite that the Respondent cannot reasonably be required to frame an answer. Accordingly, the motion is hereby granted.


The Board directs the above-named Complainant to serve upon the Respondent one copy and file with the Board, with proof of service, the original and five (5) copies of the requested particularization of the complaint by 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of this order. If the Complainant fails to timely file and serve the particularization, the Board shall dismiss the complaint.

The Respondent is directed to serve upon the Complainant one copy and file with the Board, with proof of service, the original and five copies of the answer by 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of the Complainant's particularization. If the Respondent fails to timely file and serve the answer, such a failure shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the complaint and the particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
