ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S SECOND  
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

On March 31, 1988, Complainant HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, City and County of Honolulu [hereinafter referred to as Complainant], requested a second continuance of the hearing scheduled for April 4, 1988. The supporting affidavit of Jonathan Chun, Deputy Corporation Counsel, indicated that Respondent STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS [hereinafter referred to as SHOPO] had expressed a willingness to settle this matter and Complainant has not as yet taken the deposition of Richard C. Kadota. Thus, Complainant requested additional time in order to allow the parties time to settle this matter, if possible. In the event no settlement was reached, Complainant requested a continuance in order to take the deposition of Mr. Kadota. Complainant indicated that the attorney for SHOPO had no objections to the continuance.

For good cause shown, the Board grants the Complainant's second motion for continuance of hearing. Complainant shall notify the Board by 4:30 p.m., May 31, 1988, as to the status of the case. If no settlement is reached by that time, this matter will be set for hearing.
