AMENDED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT

In Order No. 694 dated April 15, 1988, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as Board] dismissed the instant matter with prejudice. Thereafter, on April 19, 1988, Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA] by and through its attorney, Dennis W. S. Chang requested reconsideration of the order on the basis that the order did not reflect HGEA's position at the Board Conference.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby amends Order No. 694, dated April 15, 1988 to read as follows:

At the Board Conference held on April 6, 1988, Complainant above-named, through her counsel, entered an oral motion to withdraw complaint. Stated reasons for the motion are that the parties have made mutual accommodations regarding the instant dispute and that the parties have agreed to settle the matter in anticipation of upcoming union elections.

Counsel for Respondent above-named had no objection to the withdrawal of the complaint as it was inappropriately filed but made a special appearance before the Board contending that the Board had no jurisdiction over this matter as it involved an internal union election.

Pursuant to Administrative Rules, Section 12-42-8(g)(3)(A), Complainant's Motion to Withdraw is granted.

The instant matter is dismissed with prejudice.
