ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR  
TAKING DEPOSITION UPON ORAL EXAMINATION

On June 28, 1988, counsel for Complainant HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, City and County of Honolulu, filed an Application for Taking Deposition Upon Oral Examination with the Board. By this application, counsel for Complainant requested leave of the Board to take the deposition of Michael K. Kaneshiro, attorney for Grievant in the related arbitration proceeding. Counsel for Complainant indicates in an attached affidavit that the deponent has information which is relevant which will establish certain facts concerning the allegations of the instant prohibited practice.


On August 1, 1988, counsel for Respondent STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS filed a memorandum in opposition to Complainant's application. After reviewing the arguments contained therein, the Board is of the opinion that
