ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION

On December 8, 1988, Respondent BOARD OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii [hereinafter referred to as Respondent], filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of the Prohibited Practice Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion and affidavit and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's motion should be granted pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-45(b).

On December 12, 1988, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA] filed a Statement of No Opposition to Motion for Particularization; Statement of Particularization with this Board. Therein, Complainant HGEA provided the Respondent with the particularization as requested.

Respondent is directed to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the Answer, with proof of service upon Complainant, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of Complainant's Statement of Particularization. The failure of Respondent to timely file its answer shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the Complaint and Particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
