ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR
CONTINUANCE OF HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE CHARGE

On December 21, 1988, Respondent BOARD OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii, by and through its attorney, Lawrence D. Kumabe, Deputy Attorney General, filed a Motion for Continuance of Hearing on Prohibited Practice Charge with this Board requesting a continuance of the hearing in the above-entitled matter from December 30, 1988 to January 15, 1989, or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard. Mr. Kumabe stated that the grounds for the continuance are based on the fact that the subject matter of the instant complaint will be moot, and that he will be unavailable at the presently scheduled hearing date because of prior commitments.

In the supporting affidavit attached to the motion, the Respondent has stated that it has revised the action of applying a condition to fill certain State-level educational officer

positions by temporary appointment which would resolve the subject matter of the dispute in this case pending before the Board. Respondent's counsel has also indicated that Complainant's counsel does not oppose the motion.


For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Respondent's motion for continuance of the hearing.
