ORDER OF DISMISSAL


On June 7, 1989, Petitioner UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY [hereinafter referred to as UHPA], by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Rule, or in the Alternative, to Reopen the Record with this Board.
