ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES FOR DISPOSITION

On July 3, 1989, Complainant ROGER R. MARTIN filed a prohibited practice complaint against the UNITED PUBLIC WORK-ERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as UPW], alleging violation of Subsection 89-13(b)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes [hereinafter referred to as HRS]. Similarly, on July 24, 1989, UPW filed a prohibited practice complaint against Bernard Akana and County of Hawaii, Department of Parks and Recreation, alleging violations of Subsections 89-13(a)(1), (3), (4), (5), (7) and (8), HRS. The complaints arise from a change in hours of work granted to MARTIN without prior notification, negotiation, or agreement with UPW.

On August 3, 1989, UPW filed motions to consolidate Case No. CU-01-62 and Case No. CE-01-129. The affidavits of UPW's counsel attached to the motions indicate that the events which led to the complaints are similar, as are the defenses

and issues. As such, to avoid inconsistent rulings, UPW's counsel contends that the cases should be consolidated.

As these complaints involve substantially the same parties and issues, the Board finds that consolidation of the proceedings would be conducive to the proper dispatch of business and the ends of justice and will not unduly delay the proceedings. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(13), these complaints and the proceedings thereon are hereby consolidated for disposition.
