On September 15, 1989, Complainant above-named filed an Application for Withdrawal of Prohibited Practice Complaint Without Prejudice, accompanied by the affidavit of Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq., with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as Board].
