ORDER GRANTING INTERVENOR'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING DATE AND TO SET PREHEARING CONFERENCE


On January 19, 1990, the Intervenor, by and through its counsel, Sean Kim, Esq., filed a Motion to Continue Hearing Date and to Set Prehearing Conference with this Board. In his supporting affidavit, counsel states that the presently scheduled hearing date of February 1, 1990 is inappropriate since (a) the issues involved in this matter are not as simple as the Petitioner claims, (b) prehearing discovery is required in this case and (c) the hearing date was set without the participation of the Intervenor's counsel.
