On February 22, 1990, the parties above-named filed a Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board. Said stipulation stated that in consideration of the settlement agreement reached between the parties, this case may be dismissed with prejudice.

The parties are instructed to adhere in the future in similar circumstances to the procedures observed herein.
