ORDER GRANTING SHOPO'S EX PARTE
MOTION TO RESCHEDULE HEARING DATE; NOTICE
OF HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On July 27, 1990, the STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO) filed a prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant alleges that on or about July 23, 1990, Respondent KAUAI POLICE DEPARTMENT, County of Kauai, informed Complainant of its refusal to recognize and bargain with duly elected and appointed officials of SHOPO in violation of Section 89-13(a)(1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (7) and (8), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

At the prehearing conference held in this matter on September 25, 1990 by conference call, the hearing was scheduled to be held in Kauai on October 19, 1990 at 10:00 a.m. Thereafter, on September 27, 1990, Complainant SHOPO, by and through its legal counsel, Michael K. Kaneshiro, filed an Ex Parte

Motion to Reschedule Hearing Date with this Board. The motion requested that the Board reschedule the hearing in the above-entitled case from October 19, 1990 to October 26, 1990 at 10:00 a.m. In his supporting affidavit, Complainant's counsel states that such continuance is necessary because witnesses to the proceedings will be unable to testify on the presently scheduled hearing date. Kaneshiro's affidavit also indicates that counsel for Respondent, Peter M. Morimoto, Deputy County Attorney, does not object to the continuance.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, the Board hereby grants Complainant's Motion to Reschedule the Hearing Date.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing, pursuant to Sections 89-5(b)(4) and 89-14, HRS, and Administrative Rules Sections 12-42-49 and 12-42-8(g) on the instant complaint on October 26, 1990 at 10:00 a.m. in the County Council Chambers, 4396 Rice Street, Second Floor, Lihue, Hawaii 96766. The purpose of the hearing is to receive evidence and arguments on whether Respondent committed prohibited practices by its alleged refusal to recognize and bargain with duly elected and appointed officials of SHOPO. The hearing may continue from day-to-day until completed.

All parties have the right to appear in person and to be represented by counsel or other representatives.
