For good cause shown, the subject motion is granted. Respondents' counsel shall keep the Board informed about the status of this case and the progress of the negotiation efforts.


YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the prehearing conference and hearing on the instant matter is continued until further moved on by one or more of the parties herein.
