ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO
CONTINUE PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING

On June 1, 1992, Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its counsel, Dennis W. S. Chang, filed Respondent's Motion to Continue Pre-hearing Conference and Hearing. The affidavit of counsel attached to the motion indicates that a family emergency prevented him from participating in the pre-hearing conference which was scheduled on May 26, 1992 and the hearing scheduled on June 1, 1992. 

YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that the hearing in this matter will be continued until June 26, 1992 at 10:00 a.m. in the County Council Chambers, 4396 Rice Street, second floor, Lihue, Kauai. The hearing may continue from day-to-day until completed.
