ORDER GRANTING AMENDMENT OF COMPLAINT

On March 13, 1991, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA), by and through its counsel, moved this Board for an order granting its request to amend its Complaint to include an additional violation of Chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), by Respondent BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii (BOR) since the filing of the complaint. Thereafter, on March 19, 1991, Respondent BOR filed a memorandum in opposition to UHPA's motion. On March 27, 1991, the parties filed a stipulation to amend the complaint and to withdraw UHPA's motion for leave to amend.

As the BOR does not object to the amendment of the complaint, the Board in its discretion, pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-43, grants the amendment of the complaint. UHPA's complaint is amended to include the following allegation:

"Complainant has demanded bargaining over any changes in the practice of the parties pertinent to confidentiality, as it may have been

affected by the provisions of HRS, Chapter 92F, as interpreted by the Office of Information Practices, State of Hawaii. The Respondent has failed or refused to bargain in violation of Section 89-13(a)(5), H.R.S."
