OF TIME TO FILE RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT


On September 16, 1992, Respondents BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii and JOHN D. WAIHEE, III, Governor of the State of Hawaii (BOR), by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to extend the time to file respondents' motion for summary judgment. At the prehearing conference held on August 19, 1992, the parties agreed to file motions for summary judgment on or before September 21, 1992. Respondents' counsel seeks an extension of time up to and including September 28, 1992 to file the motion.

In her supporting affidavit, Deputy Attorney General Kathleen Racuya-Markrich stated that due to an illness she needs additional time to complete the motion. She indicates that opposing counsel, Charles K. Y. Khim, Esq., has no objections to the extension for filing the cross-motions.

For good cause shown, Respondents' motion is hereby granted. The motions for summary judgment in this case shall be filed by 4:30 p.m. on September 28, 1992.
