ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

On September 25, 1992, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its attorney, filed a motion to extend the time within which to file the cross motions for summary judgment. Complainant's counsel seeks an extension of time up to and including October 12, 1992 to file the motion.
