ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY MEMORANDA


On October 16, 1992, Respondents BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii and JOHN D. WAIHEE, Governor, State of Hawaii, by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to extend the time within which to file a reply memorandum to Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO's (HGEA'S) motion for summary judgment. Respondents' counsel seeks an extension of time up to and including November 4, 1992 to file a reply memorandum to HGEA's motion.

In her supporting affidavit, Deputy Attorney General Kathleen Racuya-Markrich stated that additional time was necessary to obtain necessary answering affidavits and to adequately reply to Complainant's motion. She indicates that Complainant's counsel, Charles K.Y. Khim, Esq., has no objections to the extension.

For good cause shown, Respondents' motion is hereby granted. The memoranda in reply to the respective motions for summary judgment shall be filed with the Board by 4:30 p.m. on November 4, 1992.
