ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY MEMORANDA

On November 2, 1992, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) by and through its counsel, Charles K.Y. Khim, Esq., filed a motion to extend the time within which to file a reply memorandum to Respondents BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii and JOHN D. WAIHEE, III, Governor of the State of Hawaii (collectively BOR)'s motion for summary judgment. Complainant's counsel seeks an extension of time up to and including November 18, 1992 to file a reply memorandum to BOR's motion.

In his supporting affidavit, Khim stated that additional time was necessary to file the memorandum due to conflicts in his schedule and the fact that further investigation is necessary. He


indicated that Respondents' counsel, Deputy Attorney General Kathleen Racuya-Markrich has no objections to the extension.

For good cause shown, Complainant's motion is hereby granted. The memoranda in reply to the respective motions for summary judgment shall be filed with the Board by 4:30 p.m. on November 18, 1992.
