ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO ADMIT  
POST-HEARING EVIDENCE AND REQUESTING FURTHER BRIEFING

On December 11, 1992, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA) filed a motion to admit post-hearing evidence and to request an expedited decision and order. Complainant seeks to admit a copy of the notice of applications for Position No. 82701, Director of Admissions and Records, dated December 7, 1992 into evidence as Complainant's Exhibit No. 6. Having received no objections from the Respondent, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to admit the post-hearing evidence.

In addition, the Board requests further briefing from the parties addressing the issue of whether the assignment of bargaining unit work to nonbargaining unit or managerial employees constitutes a prohibited practice. The briefs should thoroughly discuss the issue, including statutory and case authorities, incorporating relevant facts elicited from the hearing in this

case. Briefs shall be filed with the Board no later than 4:30 p.m.  
on March 5, 1993.
