ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO ADMIT POST-HEARING EVIDENCE AND REQUESTING FURTHER BRIEFING

On December 11, 1992, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA) filed a motion to admit post-hearing evidence and to request an expedited decision and order.
