ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S  
MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE BRIEFS

On February 26, 1993, the Board issued Order No. 924 which, inter alia, requested the parties to submit further briefs on the issues in this case. The Board set March 5, 1993 as the deadline to file the briefs. On March 5, 1993, counsel for Respondent BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii (BOR) requested an extension of two weeks, up to and including March 19, 1993, within which to file its brief. In his affidavit attached to the motion, Deputy Attorney General Francis Paul Keeno stated that he requires the additional time to file his brief because of workload and personal obligations. He indicates that the request is not made with the intent to delay the proceedings.

Also on March 5, 1993, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA) submitted its brief and a memorandum in opposition to the BOR's motion. Complainant UHPA argued that

because of the time frame of this case, UHPA requested that any extension be limited to one week.


The Board is mindful that Complainant UHPA requested an expedited decision in this case because the position which is the subject of the prohibited practice complaint is currently being recruited for by the BOR. However, counsel for Respondent cites good cause for the extension. The Board hereby grants Respondent's motion for an extension of time within which to file its brief. Respondent shall file its brief by the close of business on March 19, 1993.

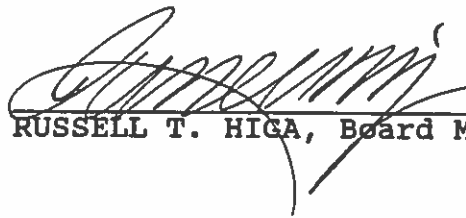
