CONTINUE PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING


On March 15, 1993, Respondents CHARLES T. TOGUCHI, Superintendent of Education, and DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii, by and through their counsel, Robert A. Marks, Attorney General, State of Hawaii and Deputy Attorney General Francis Paul Keeno filed its third motion to continue both the prehearing conference and hearing presently scheduled for March 17, 1993 and March 31, 1993, respectively, for thirty days. The affidavit of Keeno attached to the motion indicates that Complainant filed grievances with the Employer and also a complaint with the Hawaii Civil Rights Commission. Keeno submits that a continuance is necessary to attempt to resolve all of Complainant's actions.


