## ORDER DENYING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION

On June 10, 1993, Respondent UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its attorney, Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq., filed a Motion for Particularization of the Complaint with the Board. In the motion, Takahashi requested Complainant to provide specific information relating to grievances which Complainant allegedly submitted to agents or officers of Respondent UPW on his behalf and on behalf of other Adult Corrections Officers.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion supported by Takahashi's affidavit, and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint should be denied. The Complainant alleges that he submitted certain documents to the UPW which were not acted upon or responded to. The Board finds that the instant Prohibited Practice Complaint is sufficiently specific to identify the documents allegedly submitted to the UPW.

The Board directs Respondent to file with the Board the original and five (5) copies of its answer to the instant Prohibited Practice Complaint, with proof of service upon Complainant, within five working days of the receipt of this order.
