ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR INTERVENTION


On June 28, 1993, Waste Management of Hawaii, Inc. (Petitioner), by and through its attorneys, filed a Petition for Intervention with the Board. Thereafter, on July 6, 1993, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) filed a memorandum in opposition to Waste Management of Hawaii, Inc.'s Motion for Intervention. On July 7, 1993, Respondents STEVEN K. YAMASHIRO, et al., by and through their attorneys, filed a Statement Supporting Waste Management of Hawaii, Inc.'s Petition for Intervention. A hearing on the petition was held before the Board on July 9, 1993.


Upon a review of the record, the Board finds that Petitioner has alleged a sufficient interest for its participation in the proceedings. The Board hereby grants the subject Petition for Intervention pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(14).
