ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING AND FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF

On October 27, 1993, Respondents BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii and JOHN WAIHEE, Governor, State of Hawaii (collectively Employer) filed a motion to continue the hearing of Respondents' motion to dismiss with prejudice, schedule the hearings on Respondents' motion to dismiss with prejudice and Complainant's motion to amend complaint on the same date and time, and to extend the time to file a memorandum in opposition to Complainant's motion to amend prohibited practice complaint with the Board. Respondents' counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that a continuance of the hearing and an extension to file briefs are necessary because of his caseload. Counsel states that Complainant's counsel agrees to the continuance of the hearing and the extension of time within which to file his memorandum if

the Complainant's motion to amend complaint is scheduled at the same time.

For good cause shown, the Respondents' motion is hereby granted.

The Board will conduct a hearing on Respondents' motion to dismiss with prejudice on November 22, 1993 at 10:30 a.m., in the Board's hearings room, Room 203, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. The Board will also conduct a hearing on Complainant's motion to amend prohibited practice complaint filed on October 22, 1993 at the same time. Further, Respondents may file a memorandum in opposition to Complainant's motion to amend to one week prior to the scheduled hearing of Complainant's motion to amend.
