ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO

INTERLOCUTORY ORDER STAYING ACTION OF RESPONDENTS

On November 3, 1993, Respondents JOHN D. WAIHEE, III, Governor, State of Hawaii, and BOARD OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii, by and through their attorney filed a motion to continue the hearing on Complainant's motion for interlocutory order with the Board. Respondents requested that the hearing on Complainant's motion be continued from October 15, 1993 to November 17, 1993. 
Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on September 29, 1993 remain applicable.


