
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW

On November 8, 1993, Complainant STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The affidavit of SHOPO's counsel indicates that the respective parties agree that further hearings at this time would not serve to promote industrial peace.

Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's withdrawal of the subject prohibited practice complaint without prejudice.


