On February 8, 2016, Respondent Global Resort Partners (Respondent) filed a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice (Motion) with an attached Declaration of Counsel. The Motion seeks the admission of Tressi L. Cordaro (Cordaro) to appear before the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) as Respondent's attorney *pro hac vice* in accordance with Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i (Supreme Court Rules) Rule 1.9. On February 23, 2016, Complainant Director, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Director), filed a Statement of No Opposition to Global Resort Partners' Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice (Director Response). The Board issues this order (without the necessity of a hearing pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) Section 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iv)) pursuant to HAR Section 12-42-7(c). Based on the Motion and the Director Response, the Board:

1. Grants the Motion, and Cordaro is allowed to appear before the Board as Respondent's attorney *pro hac vice* in the above-entitled matter.
2. The following conditions apply to Cordaro's appearance *pro hac vice*:

(a) Local counsel Andrew L. Pepper (Pepper) shall be Respondent's attorney of record in this matter and is responsible for all phases of this matter as Respondent's lead attorney.

(b) Service of all documents and pleadings in this matter shall be made upon Pepper (and such service shall constitute service upon Respondent and Cordaro) at the following address:

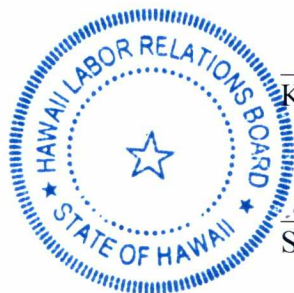
(c) Cordaro shall pay annual dues to the Hawai'i State Bar Association (HSBA) for each year this order is effective.

(d) Cordaro shall be subject to, and comply with, all applicable Board rules, and with the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct and Guidelines of Professional Courtesy and Civility for Hawai'i attorneys.

(e) Pepper shall (1) provide HSBA with a copy of this order (a copy of the transmittal to HSBA shall be filed with the Board) and (2) notify (in writing) the Board and HSBA when the above-entitled matter is closed and/or when this order is no longer valid.
