STIPULATION TO CONTINUE DISCOVERY CUTOFF,  
EXHIBIT LIST EXCHANGE, EXHIBIT, AND TRIAL DATE

WHEREAS, Order 736, Order Granting Complainant Director, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations' Motion to Compel Discovery from Respondent Tory's Roofing and Waterproofing, Inc.; Amended Pretrial Order, filed on December 21, 2015, reset the following pertinent deadlines:

Discovery Cutoff Date: March 14, 2016  
Deadline for Parties to Exchange Exhibit Lists: April 6, 2016  
Deadline to File & Exchange Copies of Proposed Exhibits: April 11, 2016  
Trial: April 13, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

WHEREAS, counsel for the Director who was previously handling this case recently retired on February 29, 2016, and the undersigned counsel has just begun to review and prepare the case;

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2016, the undersigned counsel for the Director received from Michael W. Tory, vice president of Respondent, a letter requesting a continuance of the trial date to after October 2016, because of the "tremendous amount of work" scheduled by Respondent.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS and CERTIFIED CONSTRUCTION, INC., by and through their respective counsels, to continue the: 1) discovery cutoff date, 2) deadline for parties to exchange exhibit lists, 3) deadline to file and exchange copies of proposed exhibits, and 4) trial date. The parties are agreeable to having the Labor Board set a status conference with its representatives for the purpose of resetting these deadlines.

This stipulation is not submitted for the purpose of delay.



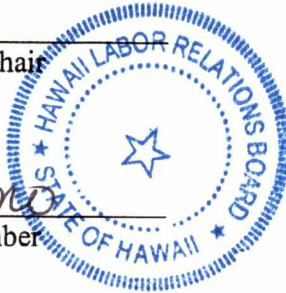
