On November 7, 2019, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO filed a Motion for Board Consent to Withdraw Without Prejudice Prohibited Practice Complaint (Motion for Board Consent) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board).

Hawai'i Administrative Rule § 12-42-8(g)(3)C(iii) allows a party to respond to a motion within five days after service.

On November 14, 2019, Respondents ROSS S. SASAMURA, P.E., Director and Chief Engineer, Department of Facility Maintenance, City and County of Honolulu; CAROLEE C. KUBO, Director, Department of Human Resources, City and County of Honolulu; and KIRK

CALDWELL, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu (collectively, Respondents), filed Respondents' Statement Re: Union's Motion for Board Consent to Withdraw Without Prejudice Prohibited Practice Complaint (Respondents' Statement). In Respondents' Statement, Respondents requested that the Board dismiss this case with prejudice.

Accordingly, the Board grants in part and denies in part the Motion for Board Consent and dismisses the case with prejudice. This case is closed.
