On June 9, 2020, Complainant HAWAII STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (HSTA), filed Complainant HSTA's Motion to Withdraw Without Prejudice its First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint and Petition for Declaratory Order and Injunctive Relief Filed on April 13, 2020 (Motion to Withdraw).

Hawai'i Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii) permits parties to file a response to a motion within five days after service of the motion papers.

On June 15, 2020, Respondents DAVID IGE, Governor, State of Hawai'i, and DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawai'i, filed Respondents David Ige and Department of Education, State of Hawaii's Statement of No Opposition to Complainant HSTA's Motion to Withdraw Without Prejudice Its First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint and Petition for Declaratory Relief, Filed June 9, 2020.
