## ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONDENTS TO SUBMIT STATUS REPORTS AND RESPONSE TO THE AMENDED COMPLAINT FILED ON MAY 13, 2020

On January 3, 2020, Complainant DAVIS T. PILI ("COMPLAINANT") filed his prohibited practice complaint with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board ("BOARD") against Respondents DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, State of Hawai'i and NOLAN ESPINDA, Director, Department of Public Safety, State of Hawai'i (collectively referred to as "RESPONDENTS") for alleged violations under § 89-13, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, ("HRS").

On March 16, 2020, the Board issued Order No. 3592, ORDER CANCELLING HEARING DATES AND DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO SUBMIT STATUS REPORTS. Among other things, Order No. 3592 cancelled a scheduled Status Conference and Hearing on the Merits and ordered the parties to file a status report no later than April 17, 2020 with the following

information: (1) the current state of the case in terms of arbitration; and (2) the party's perspective on the current issues in the case.

On March 23, 2020, the Board issued Order No. 3595, EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING ALL PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE HAWAI'I LABOR RELATIONS BOARD. The order contained the following order, among others, "All filing or other deadlines established by Pretrial Orders, including any amendments, or other Board orders are hereby suspended until rescheduled by the Board."

On April 17, 2020, Complainant filed his STATUS REPORT OF COMPLAINANT DAVIS T. PILI.


On May 13, 2020, Complainant filed his MOTION TO AMEND PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT (Motion) with Exhibit 1: entitled 2<sup>nd</sup> Amended PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT and Exhibit 2: entitled Continuation of 2<sup>nd</sup> Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint.

On May 19, 2020, the Board issued Order No. 3605, SECOND EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING ALL PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE HAWAI'I LABOR RELATIONS BOARD that ordered, among others, that "All filings in all cases before the Board during the emergency period <u>must be made electronically through the Board's filing service File&ServeXpress</u> (FSX), unless otherwise ordered by the Board.

## **ORDER**

- (1) Parties to submit their status reports pursuant to Order No. 3592; and
