ORDER DISMISSING THE CASE WITH
PREJUDICE AND CLOSING THE CASE

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On February 20, 2020, Complainant PHILIP THORP (Complainant) filed a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) against Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION (HGEA).

On June 22, 2020, the Board issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss (Notice) in this proceeding.

The Notice stated that the case would be dismissed "unless a written objection is received from any party **within ten days of issuance of this Notice**, setting forth good cause as to why the case should not be dismissed." (Emphasis in original)

In the ten-day period, the Board received no written notification from either party setting forth reasons why this case should not be dismissed. Therefore, the Board hereby dismisses the case. This case is closed.
