ORDER REQUIRING COMPLAINANT TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE TO THE BOARD

On November 16, 2020, Complainant KEVIN D. SANTANA, SR. (Mr. Santana or Complainant) filed a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) alleging that Respondent UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS (UPW) committed a prohibited practice when it refused to take two grievances to arbitration.

The Board held a prehearing conference on December 1, 2020, where the Board, among other things, went over the procedures of the case with Mr. Santana, including the fact that the Board, as a neutral party **does not and cannot provide legal advice or counsel**. The Board also requested certain information from Mr. Santana.

<u>Accordingly, the Board orders</u> Mr. Santana to file the letters from UPW that, in effect, state that UPW accepts the Step 2 decision and/or refuses to take the grievance to arbitration.
