ORDER DISMISSING THE COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE AND CLOSING THE CASE

On April 16, 2019, Respondents UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS; DAYTON NAKANELUA, State Director, UPW; MELANIE SAITO, Maui Division Director, UPW; and JULIE MIYAGAWA, Business Agent, UPW (collectively "Respondents") filed correspondence from the Complainant CURT TOKUNAGA (Complainant or Mr. Tokunaga) (Correspondence) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board). The Correspondence stated that Mr. Tokunaga "would like to have [his] case dismissed and focus on [his] health."

On April 17, 2019, the Parties submitted a Stipulation and Agreement to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint and Dismiss with Prejudice (Stipulation).

Accordingly, based on the Stipulation of the Parties, the Board dismisses the complaint with prejudice. This case is closed.


