ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE

On April 30, 2019, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) against Respondents DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, State of Hawai'i; RYKER WADA, Director, Department of Human Resources Development, State of Hawai'i; and LINDA CHU-TAKAYAMA, Director, Department of Taxation, State of Hawai'i (collectively, Respondents) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board).

On May 1, 2019, the Board issued Order No. 3495, Pretrial Order and Notices, which, among other things scheduled a prehearing conference for May 16, 2019 (Prehearing Conference) and set other hearing dates and various deadlines.

On May 15, 2019, Complainant filed the Parties' Stipulation and Order to Continue Pretrial Conference Scheduled for May 16, 2019, and the Parties' Stipulation to Continue Prehearing Conference Scheduled for May 16, 2019.

Due to the fact that the parties have not waived the requirements of HRS § 377-9(b) and Hawai'i Administrative rules (HAR) § 12-42-46(b), mandating that the HOM "be held no less than ten nor more than forty days after the filing of the complaint or amendment thereof..." the Board hereby grants the Stipulation to Continue Prehearing Conference Scheduled for May 16, 2019 and cancels the Prehearing Conference. The Board further denies the Parties' Stipulation and Order to Continue Pretrial Conference Scheduled for May 16, 2019.

All other dates and deadlines set forth in Order No. 3495 remain in effect.
