ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, UPW'S MOTION TO SCHEDULE  
STATUS CONFERENCE; NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE

On July 22, 2019, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) filed UPW's Motion to Schedule Status Conference (Motion for Status Conference) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board). In its Motion for Status Conference, UPW requested that, within sixty (60) days of June 19, 2019, the Board schedule a status conference for the purpose of expediting a resolution of issues before the Board. In the Declaration of Herbert Takahashi submitted in support of the Motion to Reschedule, Mr. Takahashi declared that the parties have reached a settlement of the case and what remains to be determined is to identify the employees who will be receiving back pay.

Respondents ROSS S. SASAMURA, P.E., Director and Chief Engineer, Department of Facility Maintenance, City and County of Honolulu; CAROLEE C. KUBO, Director, Department of Human Resources, City and County of Honolulu; and KIRK CALDWELL, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu (collectively City Respondents) filed no response to the Motion for Status Conference within the five days permitted by Hawai'i Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii).<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, the Board grants, in part, the UPW's Motion for Status Conference. While granting the UPW's request for a Status Conference, the Board is unable to accommodate UPW's request to hold the Conference "within sixty (60) days of June 19, 2019[.]"
