On August 16, 2010 Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), filed a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (HLRB) against Respondents LINDA LINGLE, Governor, State of Hawaii; LAURA H. THIELEN, Chairperson, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii; MARK S. YOUNG, Administrator, Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii; and RUSSELL Y. TSUJI, Acting First Deputy, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, (collectively, Respondents).

On February 26, 2021, HGEA filed its Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint Filed August 16, 2010 (Motion to Withdraw).

On March 1, 2021, Respondents filed Respondents' Statement of No Opposition to HGEA/AFSCME's Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint.

Accordingly, the Board grants the Complainant's Motion to Withdraw. This case is closed.
