ORDER DISMISSING THE CASE WITH PREJUDICE AND CLOSING THE CASE

The Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) held a Prehearing Conference in this case on April 1, 2021. At the Prehearing Conference, Complainant NARCIS D. SALERA (Complainant), through his counsel, admitted that the complaint in this case is substantially similar to the proposed First Amended Complaint in Board Case No. 20-CE-01-952, Salera v. Yokoyama (952). Accordingly, the Board issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss this case based on Hawai'i Administrative Rules § 12-42-42(f), which states that "Only one complaint shall issue against a party with respect to a single controversy." The Notice of Intent to Dismiss further stated stated that the case would be dismissed "unless a written objection is received from any party within ten days of issuance of this notice, setting forth good cause as to why the case should not be dismissed."

In the ten-day period, the Board received no written notification from either party setting forth reasons why this case should not be dismissed. Therefore, the Board dismisses the case. This case is closed.
