ORDER DISMISSING AND CLOSING THE CASE

The Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) held a hearing on the merits (HOM) in this case on April 20, 2021. During the course of the HOM, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) and Respondent HAWAII STATE HOSPITAL, Department of Health, State of Hawai'i (HSH) agreed to stipulate that they would immediately enter into a meaningful consultation regarding the new facility, they would identify any negotiable items and, should there be any, comply with all relevant contractual provisions.

HGEA took the position that if, in the course of these consultations and potential negotiations, HGEA believes that HSH acts in bad faith, HGEA would have further recourse by filing a new prohibited practice complaint or pursuing a grievance under the relevant collective bargaining agreements.

Accordingly, as the parties have agreed to enter into this stipulation, the Board finds that there are no further issues to be determined in this case and hereby dismisses the case. This case is closed.
