ORDER SCHEDULING DUE DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF STIPULATED STATEMENT OF FACTS AND ISSUES

In Board Order No. 3735, the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) granted the parties' request to submit a stipulated statement of facts and issues to the Board. The Board set forth a deadline of May 17, 2021 for that stipulated statement of facts and issues and set a status conference to further discuss the case.

On May 17, 2021, the parties submitted a stipulation that requested to continue the due date and status conference. After consideration, the Board granted the parties' request, setting a new deadline of June 17, 2021 for that stipulated statement of facts and issues in Board Order No. 3749.

On June 17, 2021, the parties submitted a second stipulation requesting to continue the due date and status conference.

The Board, having reviewed the stipulation, will grant the parties' request to continue the due date and status conference. However, <u>any future requested changes must be submitted to</u> the Board at least five business days prior to the set deadline. If the Board is not able to

consider and issue an order on such stipulations or requests prior to the deadline, that deadline will remain in effect until and unless the Board issues an order altering that deadline.

Accordingly, the Board orders the parties to submit a stipulated statement of facts and issues to the Board by **July 16, 2021 at 4:30 p.m.**

All dates and deadlines set forth in Order No. 3749 are cancelled, including the previously scheduled Status Conference.
